STOCKHOLM (S&P Global Ratings) Nov. 25, 2025--S&P Global Ratings today withdrew its 'BBB' long-term issuer credit rating on Luxembourg-based investment holding company BevCo Lux S.a.r.l. at the company's request. The outlook was stable at the time of the withdrawal.

We also withdrew our 'BBB' issue rating on its senior unsecured notes.
